Item 11. To **CONSIDER** a proposal to respond to EDF Energy's proposals to upgrade the B1078 junctions with the A140 and the B1077

Proposal: To urgently consider in detail the implications of these proposed highway works, to investigate further and to formulate a response by the consultation closing date of 29th. March 2019

EDF Energy has commenced what has been described as a Stage 3 pre-application Consultation in respect of a proposal to construct Sizewell C Nuclear Power Station. The summary document runs to 44 pages and is available on the following link: <https://www.edfenergy.com/energy/nuclear-new-build-projects/sizewell-c/proposals/stage-3> .

Within the document are references to what are described as “road improvements” including the “A140/B1078 west of Coddennham: changes to signage and road markings, as well as vegetation maintenance to improve visibility and safety at the junction.”

Amongst other “improvements,” similar works are proposed at the B1077/B1078 junction.

Additional information is to be found in Volume 1 Chapter 17, and Volume 2 Chapter 12 of the main Consultation documents.

The Council are recommended to urgently consider in detail the implications of these proposed highway works, to investigate further and to formulate a response by the consultation closing date of 29th. March 2019. This will involve the matter being considered again by Council at the following meeting at which time a clearer understanding should be available.
