Hi Sarah,

Following the exchange with Sarah-Jane, I'd like to apply for a drawdown of £1,126 from the council's Neighbourhood CIL reserve to fund the cost of a wheelchair accessible recycled plastic picnic bench and two child height waste bins to be located close to the children's playpark at the recreation ground. I believe that spending on these items falls within criteria. CIL is the preferred funding source as its use is restricted to a greater degree than locality funding leaving the latter open to other organisations or projects.

If this is acceptable to you, perhaps Maggie might ask councillors to confirm agreement, pending ratification at the next meeting of the council.
